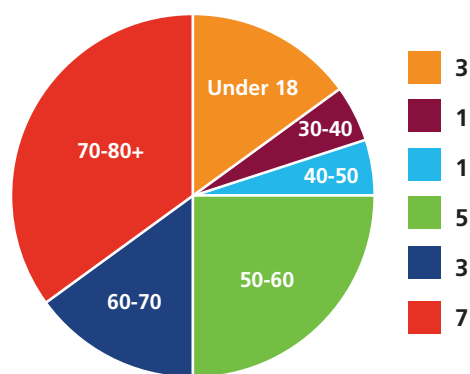
## Examples of good practice

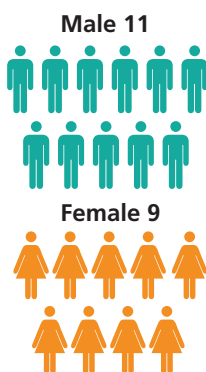

Females: 69 years Males: 61 years

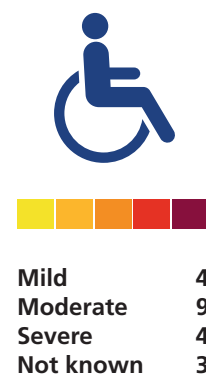
### Gender

### Level of disability



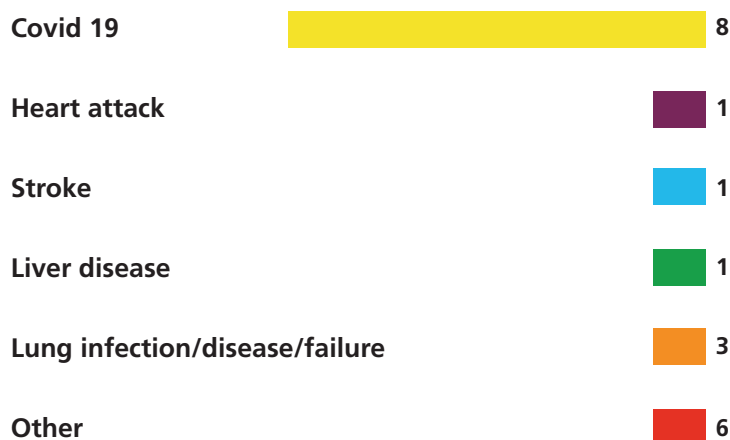
### Place of death
